Kenneth Mathews, in his commentary on Genesis, observes:

Noah is depicted as Adam redivivus (revived). He is the sole survivor and successor to Adam; both "walk" with God; both are the recipients of the promissory blessing; both are caretakers of the lower creatures; both father three sons; both are workers of the soil; both sin through the fruit of a tree; and both father a wicked son who is under a curse.

¹⁴ "Make yourself an ark of gopher wood. Make rooms in the ark, and cover it with pitch inside and outside. ¹⁵ This is how you are to make it: The ark will be 450 feet long, 75 feet wide, and 45 feet high. ¹⁶ You are to make a roof, finishing the sides of the ark to within eighteen inches of the roof. You are to put a door in the side of the ark. Make it with lower, middle, and upper decks.

¹⁷ "Understand that I am bringing a flood—floodwaters on the earth to destroy every creature under heaven with the breath of life in it. Everything on earth will perish. ¹⁸ But I will establish my covenant with you, and you will enter the ark with your sons, your wife, and your sons' wives.

100	Noah has Japheth, the first of his sons, when he was 500 years old.	<i>Genesis 5:32; 10:21</i>
98	Noah has Shem who was 100 two years after the Flood.	<i>Genesis 11:10</i>
? Perhaps 95 or 96 the same time between Japheth and Shem.	Ham was the youngest one born to Noah and was aboard the Ark, so he was born prior to the Flood.	<i>Genesis 9:24; Genesis 7:13</i>
? Perhaps 20–40 years for all of the sons to be raised and find a wife	Each son was old enough to be married before construction on the Ark begins.	<i>Genesis 6:18</i>
~ 55–75 years (estimate)	Noah was told to build the Ark, for he, his wife, his sons, and his sons' wives would be aboard the Ark.	<i>Genesis 6:18</i>

We would end up with a tentative range of about 55 to 75 years for a reasonable *maximum* time to build the Ark. Of course, it could be less than this depending on the age that Noah's sons took wives.
