

# Jesus: God's Final Word

## Why We All Need Jesus

Hebrews 7:11-22

### Context:

The 1st half of chapter 7 identifies Jesus as a \_\_\_\_\_ High Priest than Aaron and Melchizedek.

The 2nd half of the chapter tells us why the old system must necessarily give way to the new and how why the new is in all ways \_\_\_\_\_.

### We all need Jesus because ...

Not one of us is morally \_\_\_\_\_, or ever will be (and God requires moral \_\_\_\_\_).

The old system \_\_\_\_\_ them of their sinfulness, but could never \_\_\_\_\_ the problem.

Our \_\_\_\_\_ remind of our sinfulness, and our failed efforts at \_\_\_\_\_ confirm our hopelessness, *unless ...*

The old system (Mosaic) could not take us to \_\_\_\_\_ ("eschatological perfection"). It could only \_\_\_\_\_ who/what could.

If the Mosaic/Levitical system had been \_\_\_\_\_, God's Word would not have prophesied about the necessity of a new and \_\_\_\_\_ system that was to come ("the order of Melchizedek").

And because you can't separate the \_\_\_\_\_ administered by the priesthood under the from the \_\_\_\_\_ that made sacrifices necessary under the Mosaic system, and if the priesthood is giving way to a \_\_\_\_\_ one, we know that the Law too must give way to something (someone) \_\_\_\_\_.
